

Letter Instructions

Letters from a Tooth Fairy present your child with a wonderful opportunity to embark on an adventure in imagination. And you can go along for the ride! Let your delight, surprise, perplexity, and involvement mirror that of your child as you share in the interaction with our engaging tooth fairies.

In terms of logistics for this "Mischiefee's Treasure Hunt" letter, please do the following:

Prep before printing

- 1. Type your child's name in the box on the salutation line [pg. 2].
- 2. Type your child's name and the date on the Confirmation of Receipt of Goods certificate [pg. 5].
- 3. (Optional) To print envelopes, download the free templates at <u>lettersfromatoothfairy.com/free</u>.

Night 1

- 1. Remove the tooth your child left under his/her pillow and replace with:
 - Mischiefee's letter [pgs. 2 − 4]
 - Confirmation of Receipt of Goods certificate [pg. 5]
- 2. Hide the clues in the appropriate locations around your house. There are two versions of each clue: a basic version with no missing words, and a more advanced version with a missing word to solve. Use whatever version suits your child best.
 - Hide clue 2 [pg. 6 or pg. 10] next to a sink (any sink in your house)
 - Hide clue 3 [pg. 7 or pg. 11] in your child's shoe (any shoe)
 - Hide clue 4 [pg. 8 or pg. 12] by a door that leads outside
 - Hide clue 5 [pg. 9 or pg. 13] in your child's school back pack
 - Hide the ToothLoot (the money you want to leave your child) next to your child's toothbrush, along with his "Who might visit next time?" poem [pg.14]

You can skip a clue if it won't work in your house. This is why they aren't numbered.

Next Time

Continue the fun with Mischiefee next time your child loses a tooth with the second letter in his series, "Mischiefee Plays Pick a Number." In this letter, Mischiefee offers your child two choices: take the ToothLoot right away or work for it. But even work is play when Mischiefee's involved!
